NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Florida School Boards Association hereby expresses its unconditional support for all student athletes, coaches, and any employee associated with athletic activities in the high schools to exercise exemplary sportsmanship at all times as outlined by the Florida High School Athletics Association Bylaws.
